Kids Helping Kids Awards Frequently Asked Questions



Q- What is the Kids helping Kids Awards?

A- The 2010 Kids Helping Kids Awards is SchoolAid's inaugural national Awards program recognising and rewarding excellence in school based philanthropy. The Awards provide teachers and students across Australia with the opportunity to celebrate and showcase their fundraising activities whilst having the chance to win fantastic prizes! The Awards represent a first in Australian schools - the opportunity to demonstrate how your school 'walks its values talk'.

Q- Does our fundraising have to have been for a SchoolAid Project to participate in the 2010 Kids helping Kids Awards?

A- No. Most of our Awards categories allow for both SchoolAid and non-SchoolAid fundraising projects to enter into the Awards

Q- Is the Kids Helping Kids Awards entry only for Australian Primary Schools?

A- No. Secondary Schools may also to enter the awards, and will be eligible for the 'highly commended' prize in most categories. See our Terms and Conditions for more details. Only Australian Primary and Secondary School are eligible to enter the 2010 Kids Helping Kids Awards

Q- Can our fundraising group enter more than one Awards Category?

A- No. Your school will only be eligible to enter the Kids Helping Kids Awards ONCE, under the Awards Category you think will most showcase your fundraising group.

Q- What can our school win?

A- The Kids Helping Kids Awards 'Best of the Best' recipient will receive a \$10,000 cash prize, along with fantastic technology prizes donated by our Awards Partner, Microsoft. Awards Category winners will also receive a range of technology prizes, including Awards Partner Cartoon Network arranging for Ben 10 to visit YOUR school, plus race your mates on the awesomely huge Ben 10 inflatable Obstacle Course! All entries will be formally acknowledged with a Certificate of Appreciation for their outstanding fundraising achievements, and recognition on our Kids Helping Kids Awards virtual 'Honour Roll'. Prizes (kindly donated by Microsoft and Cartoon Network) include: Acer Extensa 4230 (with Bluetooth & Webcam); Aspire AS5738PZG-434G32Mn Touch; Xbox 360; Windows® 7; Microsoft® Office Ultimate 2007; HTC HD2 Windows® phone; Ben 10 visits YOUR school. Q- If our school has already registered with SchoolAid in the past, do we still need to register for the KHK Awards?

A- Yes. The Kids Helping Kids Awards is SchoolAid's unique Awards Program. You will be assigned a specific Award Registration Number when you send us your completed registration form, which will allow you to complete your entry process and be in the running to win prizes.

Q- Can our fundraising group send you through images and stories of our fundraising activities?

A- We would love that! We will be showcasing stories that we receive through the Awards process from schools and their fundraising groups on our website. Please be sure to complete the PARENT RELEASE FORM (available in the download section of Awards site) if you would like to send us photographs.

Q- What are the timelines of the Awards? when will we know if we have won a prize?

A- Your School will be notified if you are shortlisted, become a finalist, or win a category prize in the 2010 Kids Helping Kids Awards. All entrants will receive a Certificate of Appreciation, and will appear in our 'virtual' Honour Roll.
